The tests, conducted by the German investigator Michael Klieeisen at the Spanish Neuro Diagnostic Research Institute in Marbella, are the first to show how children's brains react to the use of mobile phones. With the help of a scanner, Klieeisen was able to create picture of how the brains of an 11 - year - old boy and a 13 - year - old girl reacted while they used a mobile phone. The result was compared with similar tests using adult subjects.



The tests showed that the brain activity of the child subjects was reduced significantly, especially on the side where the mobile phone was held, a few minutes after the call was begun, the report said. Also, brain activity was lower than normal in large sections of the brain for 50 minutes after the end of the call, the test results showed.

In recent years, the origin of tornado formation has been the subject of increasingly fruitful research. Nevertheless, some mystery still surrounds tornadoes, and their formation cannot be predicted with absolute accuracy, even when conditions for their occurrence seem just right.

Tornadoes are usually associated with thunderstorm conditions. They require a moist airstream that is warm for the season and usually comes from a southerly direction. Tornadoes favor the warmest part of the day, when solar heating and thunderstorm development are at their maximum.

Such a DNA bar code helped to convict Randall Jones, now on Death Row in Florida. Jones's car got stuck in the mud. In search of a tow, he found a young couple asleep in a pickup truck parked by a fishing ramp. He shot each of them in the head with a rifle, dragged their bodies into the woods, used the truck to pull out his car, and then went back and raped the woman.

In such cases, standard blood or semen analysis can identify a suspect with a certainty of about 90 to 95 percent, leaving some room for argument. However, Jones's DNA pattern, which matched the sperm found in the victim's body, could occur in only one person out of 9.34 billion-about double the present population of the world.

Mini-meals are not snack eaten between larger meals. Instead they are variety of small portions eaten throughout the day. The real challenge with this eating style is eating enough servings from each food group while not over-eating. Each mini-meal should be thought out and selected from nutritious foods, just as you would with your other meals.



A few tips can help you master grazing.

Keep each mini-meal about the same size to avoid over-eating and yet satisfy your appetite.

Appetizer-size portions in restaurants and at home are about the right size for mini-meals you eat now and divide them up throughout the day.



Grazing may not be for everyone. For some, frequent snacking could lead to overeating. Obesity experts generally advise that overweight people not graze since it may promote mindless eating. In addition, eating many times throughout the day may be inconvenient for some.

Once a bear has a taste for people food, they can be extremely persistent, says Mazur. Eleven of the 36 foodconditioned bears were involved in 90 percent of the hazing events, the researchers found. Only one of these 11 bears completely stopped entering developed areas; four changed their behavior but still had to be hazed every year. The remaining six were so persistent and potentially dangerous that they were killed or relocated.
