Present Perfect Tense



STRUCTURE

- **Sub + has / have + Verb 3**
 - He has spoken.
 - They have spoken.



Time line



How to use

Up to present time

- Ben has lived in New York since 1995.
- I have studied English for more than three years.
- He has worked in Bangkok up to the present time.



Since

Point of time (in the past)

- Since yesterday
- Since 1980
- Since World War II
- Since January
- Since the beginning of the year



Since

Since + Past Simple

- Since he was a boy.
- Since he left school.

He has lived with his uncle since he was a boy.



For

Period of time

- For two hours
- For six months
- For long time

He has waited for you for two hours.



How to use

Repeated action in the past – up to the future

- She has eaten in the restaurant many times.
- He has read this book over and over.



How to use

Never or Ever event

- I have never seen this movie before.
- We have been to China twice.
- Have you ever been abroad?



How to use

Reminding the result of the action

- She has closed the door.
- The trains have arrived at the station.



How to use

Just finished

- The Manager has just gone out.
- We have already closed the window.



Yet / Just / already

Yet (Negative) place at the end of sentence.

- He has not died yet.



Yet / Just / already

Just and Already (statement) before main verb

- He has just finished his work.
- We have already read this book.



LOOK!

Yet and Already can be used in statement.

- Already : want “YES” answer
- Yet : want “NO” answer
