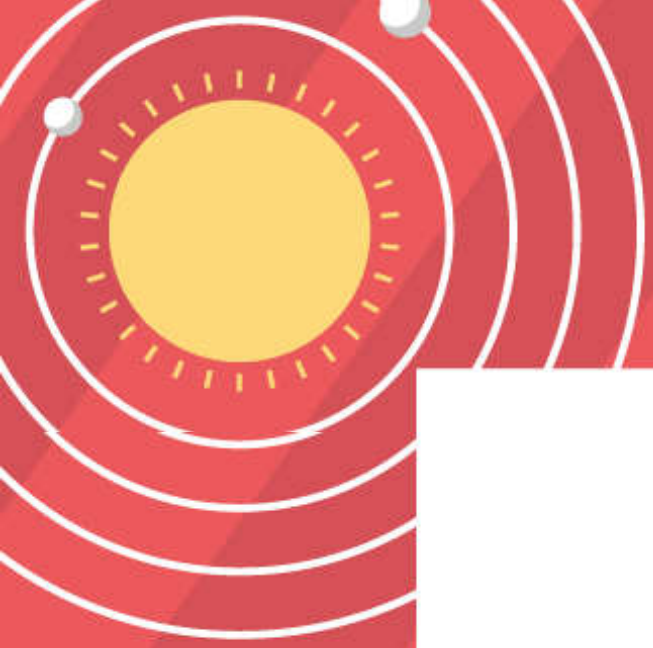

so... that

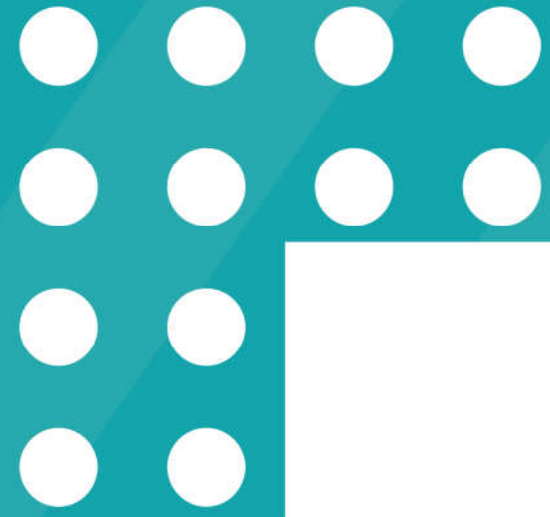
This handbag is so pricing that I can't afford it.
