


คือ คำที่ใช้บอกลักษณะของคำนาม

Adjective : tall, big, red, beautiful, dark, difficult

English grammar is **easy**.

A **red** book is on the table.

Adjective VS Adverb

คำวิเศษณ์ (ADVERB)

คือ คำที่ใช้ขยาย Verb, Adjective, Adverb

Adverb : today, actually, differently, slowly, very

Today, I swim in the morning.

Jane looks at two books on shelf **differently**.

Roger is **too** handsome tonight.

Ken drives **very fast**.

- หน้า Noun = a beautiful girl.
- หน้า V.to be = This girl is beautiful.
- หน้า Linking V. = She seems smart.


(be, become, get, grow, prove, remain, stay, turn)

Adverb

ขยาย V., Adj., Adv.

คำอเนก

- หน้า V. = She sings beautifully.
- หน้า V.(ความถี่) = I always read books.
- หน้า N. = She goes home slowly.
- หน้า Adj. = He is very smart.
- หน้า Adv. = He drives very quickly.
- หน้า ประโยค = Actually, he's good.
- หน้า ประโยค = He looks tired today.
