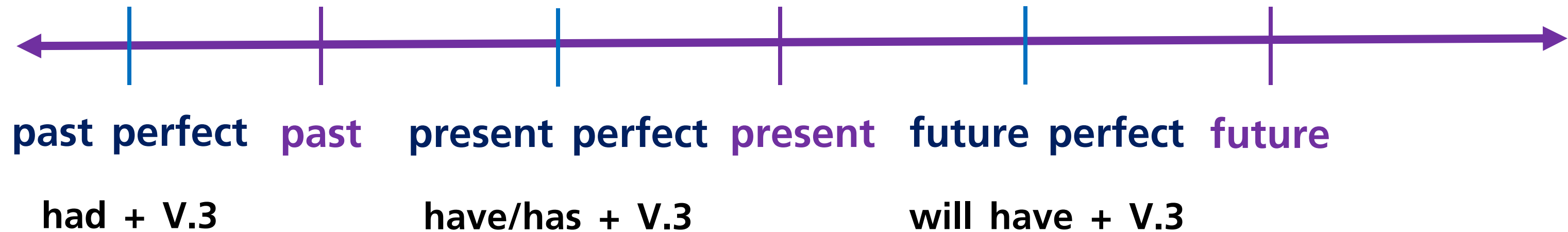

การใช้งาน

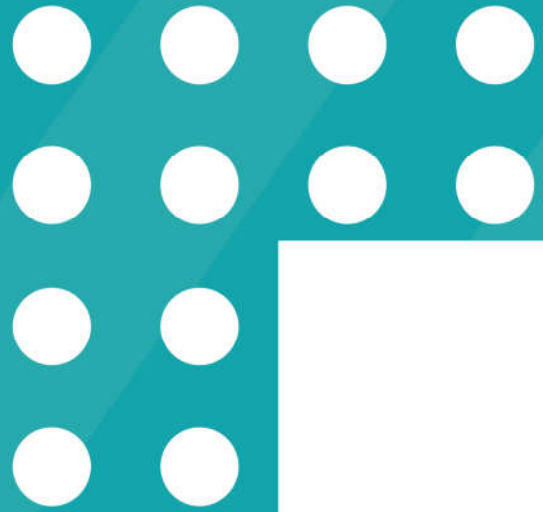
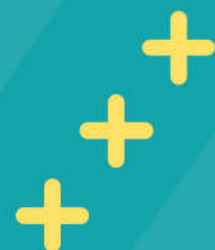
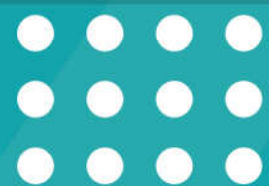
