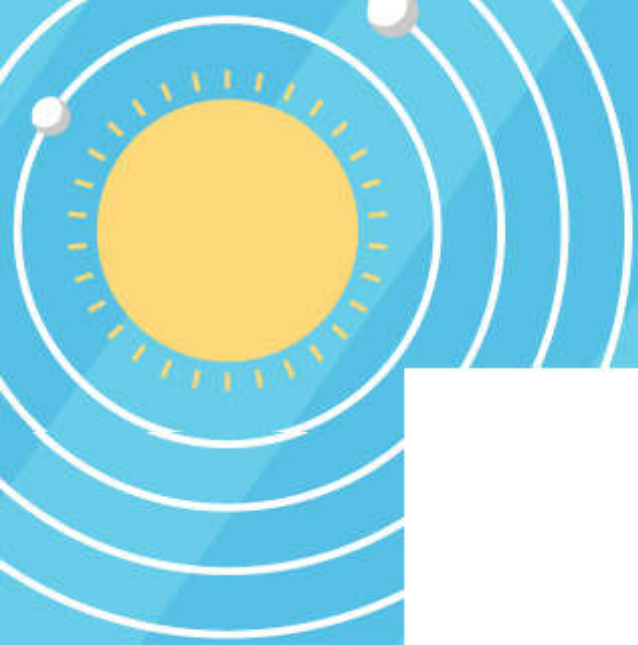

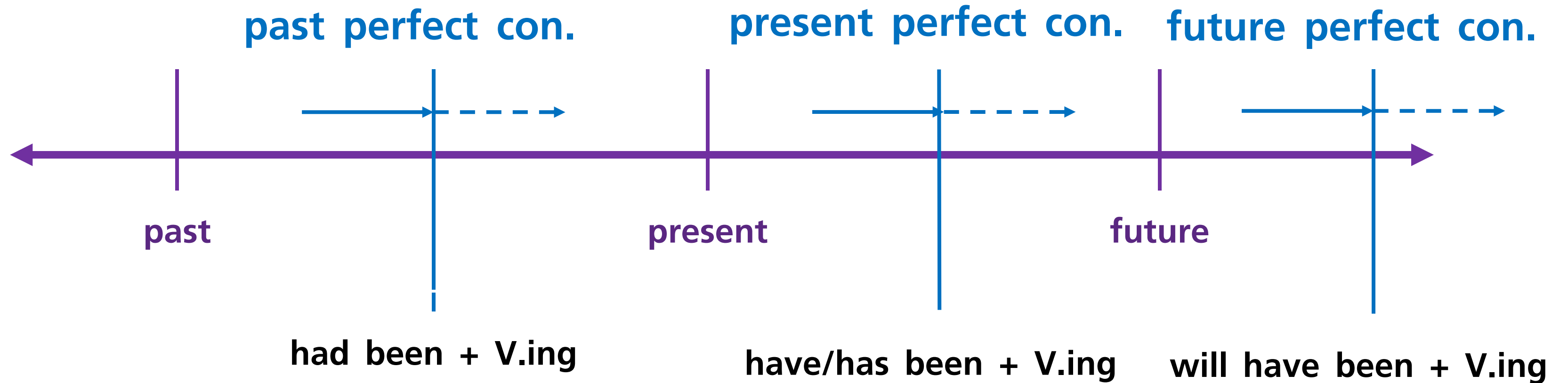

Present Perfect Continuous Tense

S + have/has been + V.ing

การใช้งาน

เหตุการณ์เสร็จแล้วส่วนหนึ่งแต่ยังไม่เสร็จทั้งหมด

I have been studying for two hours when you come.

สิ่งที่เกิดขึ้นต่อเนื่อง

I have been teaching at Topic for 12 years.

By next March, I have been living in Bangkok for 20 years.

เหตุการณ์ที่เกิดขึ้นบ่อย ๆ

I have been coughing a lot today.

Past Simple Tense

The company enforced this rules in 1998.

Present Perfect Tense

The company has enforced this rules since 1998.

Present Perfect Continuous

The company has been enforcing this rules for 20 years.



Past Perfect Continuous Tense

S + had been + V.ing

เหตุการณ์เสร็จแล้วส่วนหนึ่ง
แต่ยังไม่เสร็จทั้งหมดในอดีต

Yesterday when you came to the class,
I had been studying for 2 hours.

Jane said, "I have been gardening all of afternoon."



Jane said she had been gardening all of afternoon.



Future Perfect Continuous Tense

S + will have been + V.ing

การใช้งาน

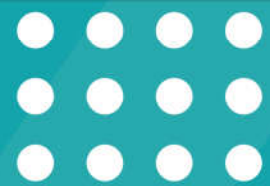
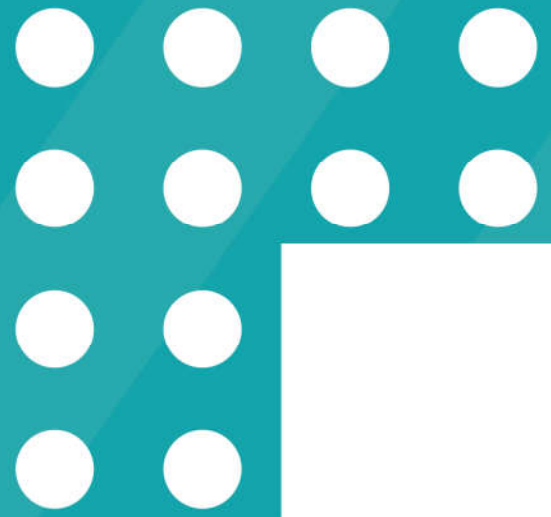
เหตุการณ์เสร็จแล้วส่วนหนึ่ง

Tomorrow when you come to the class, I will have been studying for 2 hours.

I will have been waiting here for four hours by 9 o'clock.
