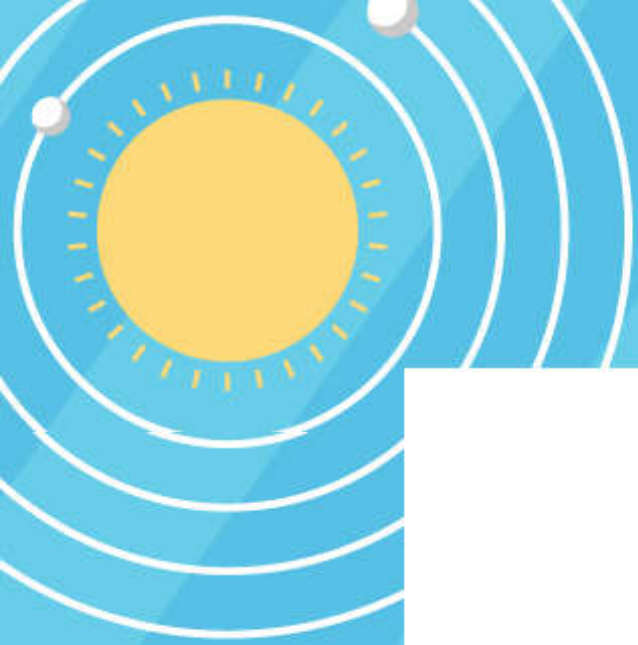

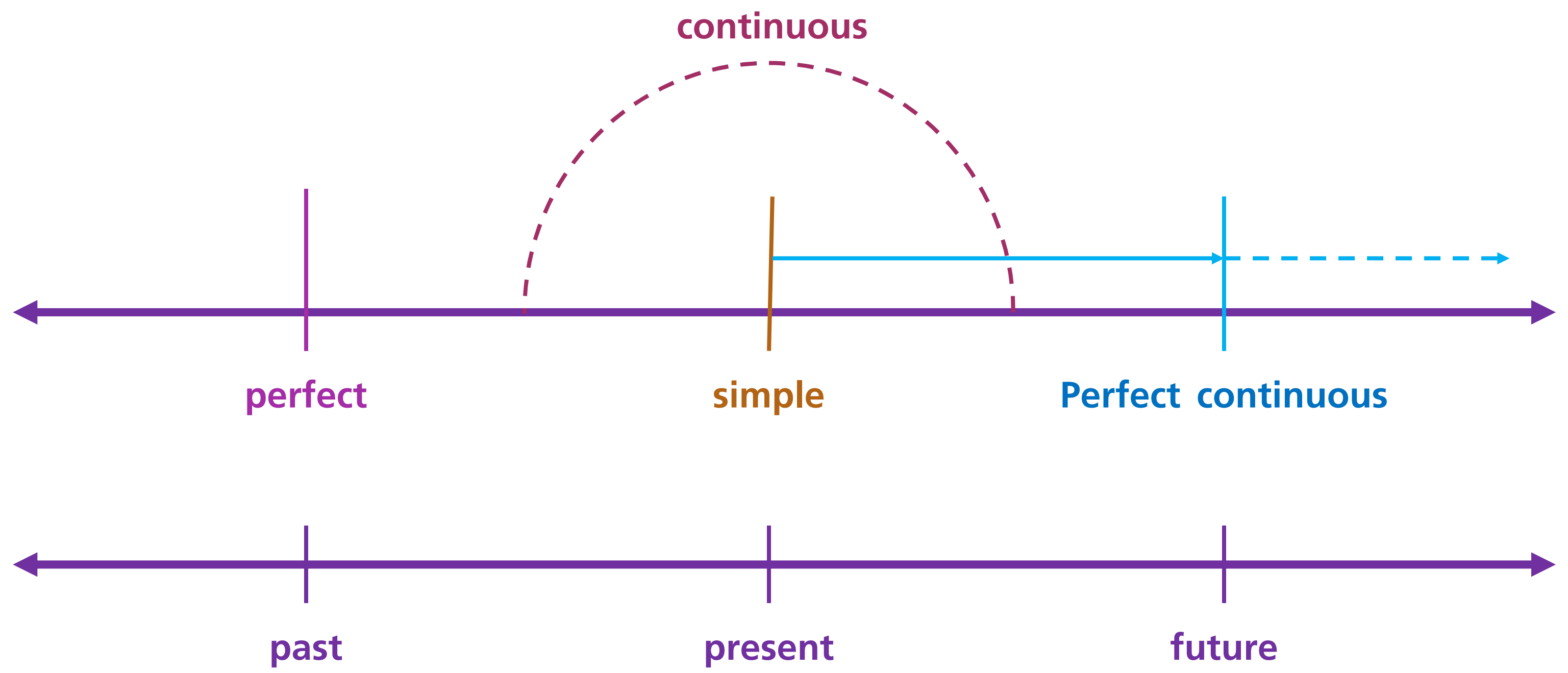

COMPARING TENSES

SIMPLE TENSE

V1 / V2 / Will+V0

เหตุการณ์โดยทั่วไป

Ex. The sun rises.

She wrote book yesterday.

He will go to Krabi next month.

สิ่งที่เกิดขึ้นโดยปกติ

Ex. I often drink milk.

She drunk everyday

when she was young.

PERFECT CONTINUOUS TENSE

will + have been +V.ing

เสร็จไปส่วนหนึ่งแล้วแต่ยังไม่เสร็จทั้งหมด

Ex. I have been making cake for three hours when you come.

Henry had been teaching here for ten years when you came.

Your shirt will have been finishing by 9 o'clock

เน้นสิ่งที่เกิดขึ้นบ่อย

Ex. Ken have been coughing all the time.

PERFECT TENSE

V.to have + V.3

เน้นสิ่งที่ทำเสร็จแล้ว

Ex. When John comes, I have taken a bath already.

Yesterday when John came, I had taken a bath already

Tomorrow when John comes, I will have taken a bath already.

เน้นสิ่งที่เกิดขึ้นแล้วแต่ยังคงพลอย

Ex. I have used this book as a main reference since 2016.

She had been there before she moved.

CONTINUOUS TENSE

V.to be + V.ing

เน้นสิ่งที่ยังทำไม่เสร็จ

Ex. I am reading this book.

When he picked me up,

I was doing my homework.

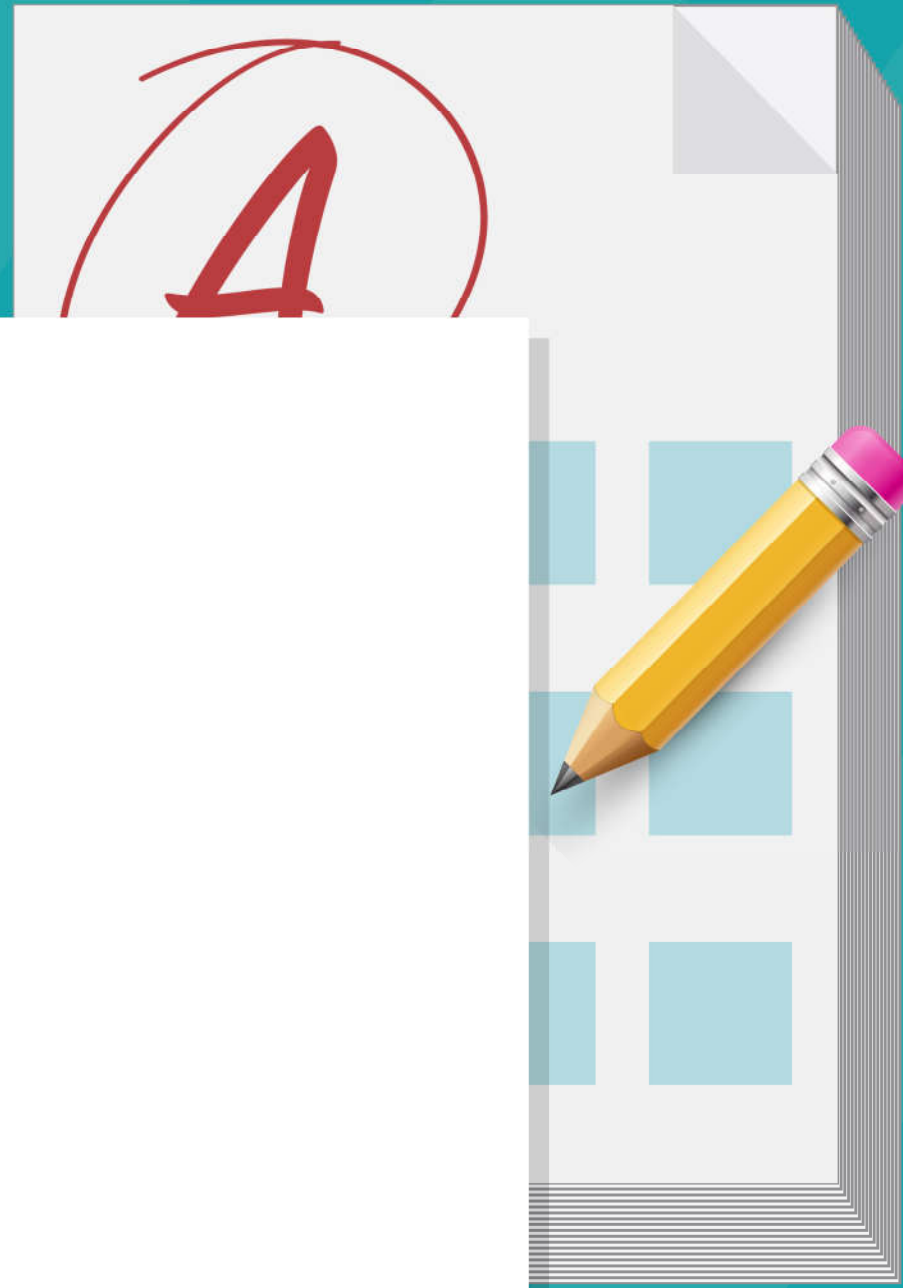
เน้นสิ่งที่ยังทำอยู่

Ex. I am learning.

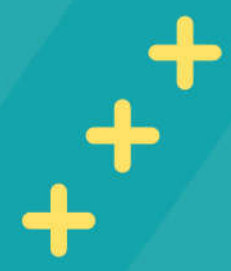
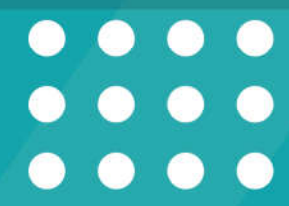
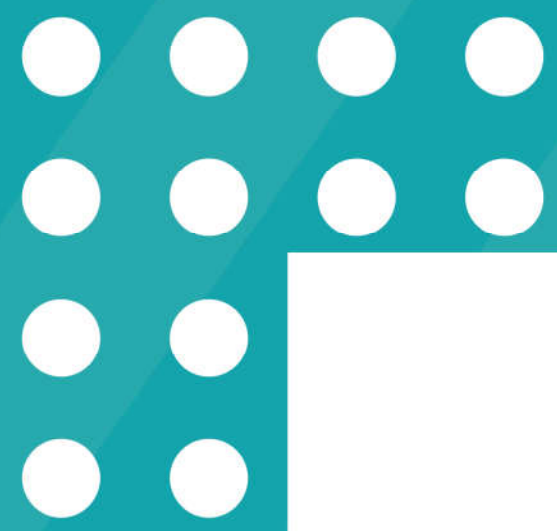
