

### **COMPARING TENSES**

#### SIMPLE TENSE

#### V1 / V2 / Will+V0

#### เหตุการณ์โดย<u>ทั่วไป</u>

Ex. The sun rises.

She wrote book yesterday.

He will go to Krabi next month.

#### PERFECT CONTINUOUS TENSE

#### will + have been +V.ing

#### เสร็จไปส่วนหนึ่งแล้วแต่ยังไม่เสร็จทั้งหมด

Ex. I have been making cake for three hours when you come. Henry had been teaching here for ten years when you came. Your shirt will have been finishing by 9 o'clock

#### เน้นสิ่งที่เกิดขึ้นบ่อย

Ex. Ken have been coughing all the time.

#### สิ่งที่เกิดขึ้นโดยปกติ

Ex. I often drink milk.

She drunk everyday

when she was young.

#### PERFECT TENSE

#### ้เน<sup>้</sup>นสิ่งที่ทำเสร็จแล<sup>้</sup>ว

Ex. When John comes, I have taken a bath already.

Yesterday when John came, I had taken a bath already

Tomorrow when John comes, I will have taken a bath already.

#### ู เน<sup>้</sup>นสิ่งท<u>ี่เกิดขึ้นแล้วแต่ยังคงพลอยู่</u>

Ex. I have used this book as a main reference since 2016.

#### **CONTINUOUS TENSE**

#### V.to be + V.ing

เน<sup>้</sup>นสิ่งที่ยัง<u>ทำไม่เสร็จ</u>

Ex. I <u>am reading</u> this book.

When he picked me up,


#### V.to have + V.3

She had been there before she moved.

#### เน<sup>้</sup>นสิ่งที่<u>ยังทำอยู่</u> Ex. I am learning. I was doing homework I <u>was doing</u> my homework. when you called. I will be sleeping before you come.


