every

every day, every month, every year, etc.

- I play badminton every day.

adverb of frequency

usually, normally, often, always, sometimes, rarely, almost, never, etc.

- My sister usually drinks coffee.

once, twice, three times

once a week, twice a month, three times a year, etc.

- The magazine publishes twice a month.



PAST SIMPLE TENSE

yesterday	- I took the math exam yesterday.
in	- I went to South Africa in 2018.
last	last night, last week, last month, last year, etc I played basketball last night.

Days ago, weeks ago, years ago, etc.

- John did this project three days ago.

...ago



FUTURE SIMPLE TENSE

	tomorrow	- I will make a strawberry cake tomorrow.
	in the future	- I will learn Spanish in the future.
	next	Next Wednesday, next month, next year, etc I will call you once again next Monday.
	soon	- The new luxury department store will arise here soon.
	later	- She will tell her decision to us later.



CONTINUOUS TENSE

Past Continuous

at the moment, when, while, last ..., ... ago, etc.

- At this time last month, I was going to Australia.
- When you came home, I was taking a bath.

Present Continuous

now, right now, recently, currently, etc.

- I am learning right now.
- When you come home, I am taking a bath.

Future Continuous

at the moment, when, while, next ..., tomorrow at ..., etc.

- At this time next March, I will be going to Canada.
- Tomorrow when you come home, I will be taking a bath.



PERFECT TENSE

Past Perfect

when, while, before, after, by the time, etc.

- By the time Henry arrived, Mary had cooked.

- When you came home, I had taken a bath already.

Present Perfect

- She has worked in the bank for six years.

- Ken has ever been to Mexico.

Future Perfect

By the time, by..., etc.

- By the time Henry arrive, I will have gone.

- I will have done my presentation by 9 o'clock tomorrow.

By the time, by..., etc.

- By the time she arrives, I will have been taking a bath for 30 minutes.
