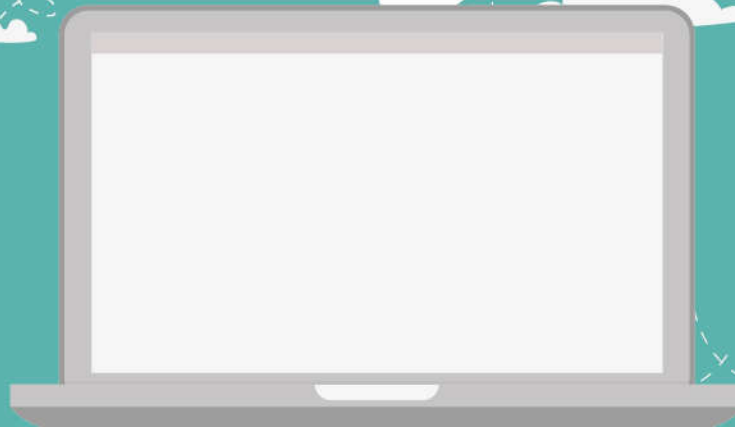

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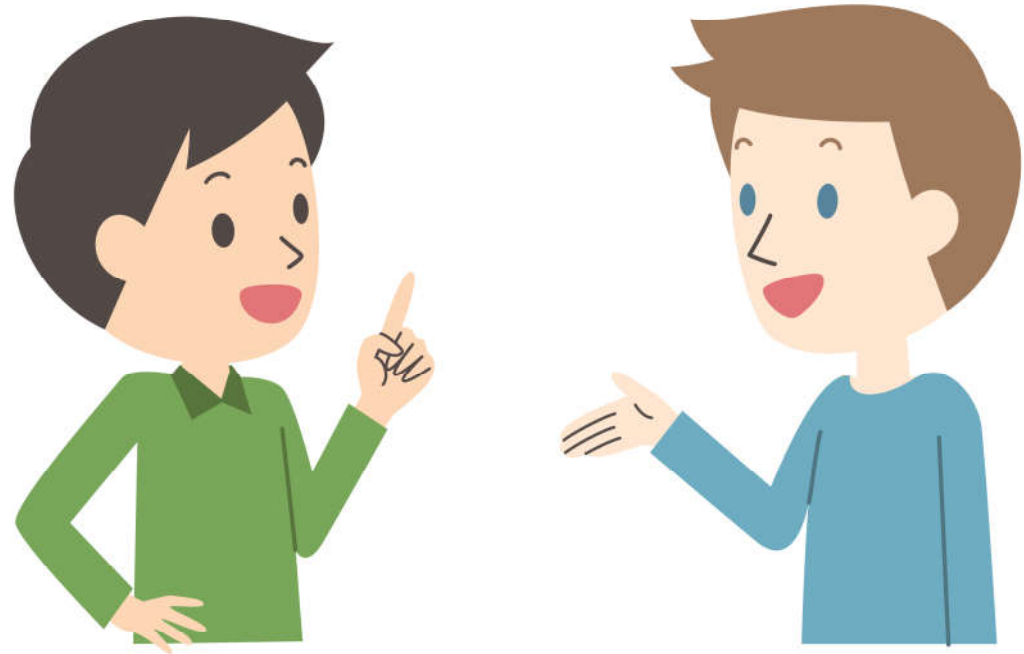

**Your English is really good.**

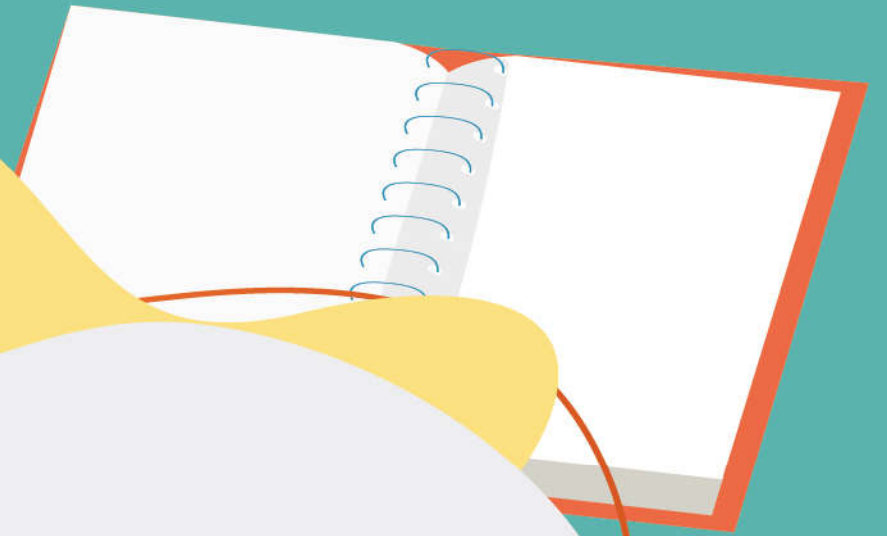
**Where do you go to school.**
