

On the Phone
Vs
Over the Phone

"On the phone"

= Someone is using a telephone.

"Don't interrupt your sister while she is on the phone."

[while she is using the phone]

"Can you turn down the TV? I am on the phone."

"He was on the phone when I arrived at his house."

"On the phone"

On the phone	On the screen
On TV	On the Internet
On the radio	On iPad
On Spotify	On the app store

"Over the phone"

= Something is done using the phone as a way to do it.

She told him that bad news over the phone.

[she used the phone to tell him the news rather than telling him in a letter or in person]

I pay my bills over the phone so I don't have to write checks. We ordered food over the phone before driving to pick it up.




- Do you want to leave a message?


