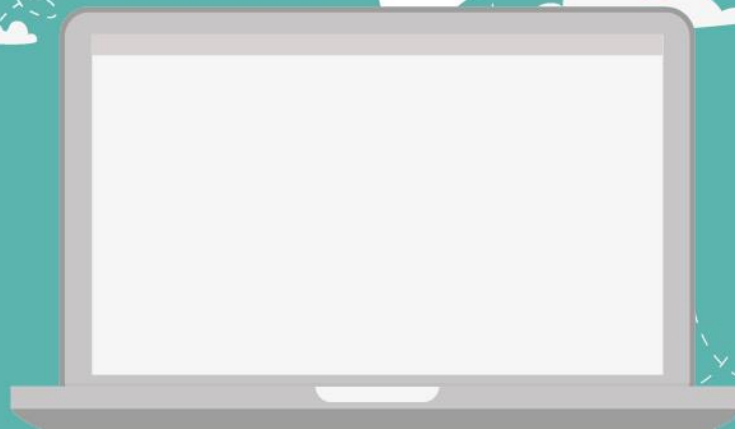

1. Get to Know Suffix -ship



Socializing and Being in Relationship

A suffix is a letter or group of letters added at the end of a word which makes a new word. It is a word ending that help indicate what part of speech a word is.

Noun Suffix | **Adjective Suffix**

Verb Suffix | **Adverb Suffix**

Socializing and Being in Relationship

“ – ship ”

is added to a noun to establish status or condition

- Indicating a state or a condition,
e.g. to be in a friendship
- Indicating the qualities belonging to a class of people,
e.g. craftsmanship
- Indicating office or profession,
e.g. ambassadorship

(adj.) ซึ่งสัมพันธ์กัน ซึ่งเกี่ยวข้องกัน

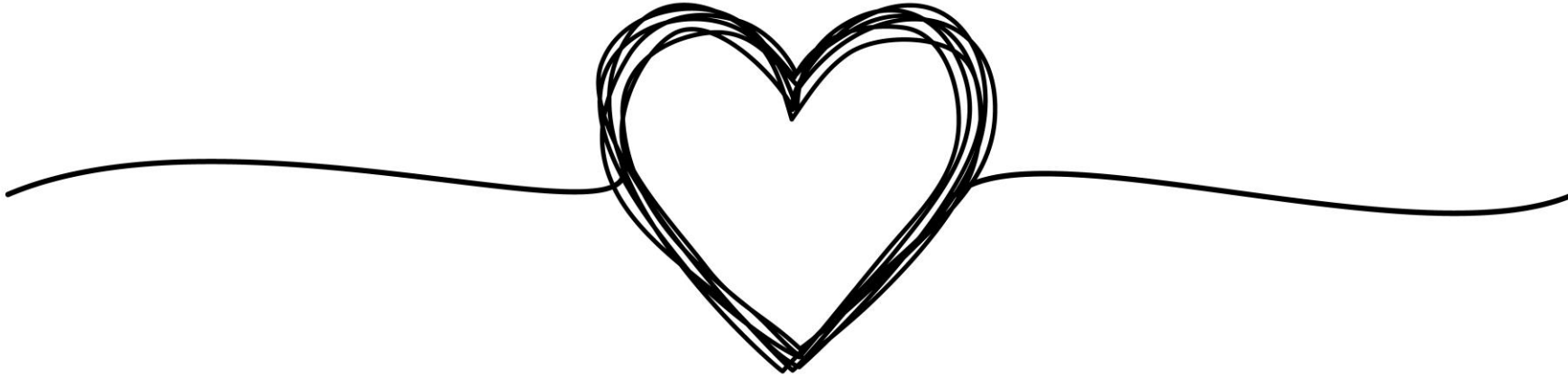

Relationship n.

- the way in which two or more people, groups, countries, etc., talk to, behave toward, and deal with each other
- a romantic or sexual friendship between two people
- the way in which two or more people or things are connected

“Mom always had a good relationship with her siblings.”

“She wanted a permanent relationship with him - marriage.”

“We are in a complicated relationship”

= No.

ឆ្នើម I'm afraid I can't. I've got lots of work to get done today.

They're getting hitched

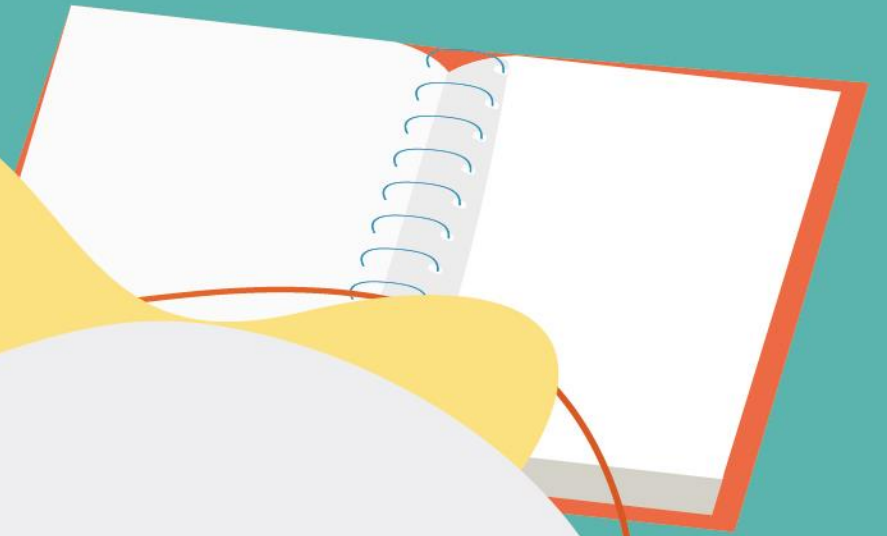
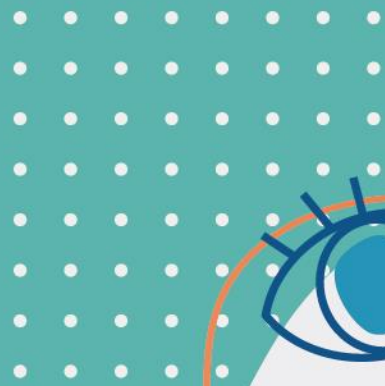
